

PARENT/GUARDIAN & SPECTATOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Submit all required League documents on a timely basis:
 - a. Parental Permission Slips must be submitted before a Player will be allowed to practice or play in any games. **The League provides no insurance for participants in the football program.** Via submission of their Parental Permission Slips, parents are assuming responsibility for the health care of their dependents. As such, a Player's parents are responsible for insuring the Player.
 - b. Emergency Information Slips must be completed and submitted so guardians can be contacted and/or so League Officials can grant permission for emergency medical care, if the need arises.
 - c. Player and Parent/Guardian Responsibility Recognition Slips must be submitted to verify that all participants understand what is expected of them.
2. Encourage dependents to participate in extra-curricular activities, but do not force them. This League is for the Players, not for the adults.
3. Encourage all Players to play by the rules of the League and the rules of the team.
4. Praise and Encourage Players and Teams based on their efforts, not on the results. Striving for success is more important than winning.
5. Never ridicule a Coach, a Referee or another Player, especially in front of any Player
6. Applaud good plays by both teams.
7. Recognize the value and importance of all League Officials, Coaches, Referees and Committee Members. They are donating their time and resources to the League.
8. Turn defeat into victory (Negative to a Positive) by helping your dependent with skill improvement and good sportsmanship.
9. **Support the League's primary goal; i.e., character development:**
 - a. **Attend speaker presentations.**
 - b. **Assist your Player complete the "Values Worksheet".**
 - c. **Review the material in the "Values Section" of the EYFL Player's Manual.**
 - d. **Assist your Player complete the "Book Report".**
 - e. **Encourage your Player to perform weekly acts of kindness and to submit a "Meritorious Acts Report".**
